## THE 6<sup>th</sup> CONGRESS OF THE ALPS ADRIA ACOUSTICS ASSOCIATION – GRAZ 2014

The 6<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Alps Adria Acoustics Association (AAAA) was held in Graz, Austria from October 16 through October 17, 2014. The Congress brought together scientists from AAAA constituents: Austria, Slovenia and Croatia, as well as from other south-eastern European countries, thus improving the mutual cooperation among the national societies for the benefit of the whole region. During the three days of the Congress, various national and international experts presented a number of scientific papers on the activities that they have undertaken in all fields of acoustics.

The scientific program included the keynote speeches given by eminent international experts along with their contributed papers. The AAAA Congress 2014 dealt with topics that are the focus of interest in the

scientific community and among researchers working in industry. A number of different aspects of acoustics, involving aircraft noise, ultrasound, noise, room acoustics, electroacoustics, hearing and musical acoustics, speech, theoretical acoustics, measurements in acoustics, vibroacoustics, virtual acoustics, numerical acoustics were held in six different sessions.

The Faculty of Transport and Traffic Sciences chaired the session of Vehicle Acoustics and Noise Reduction, in which two papers prepared by junior researchers and students from the Faculty were presented.

The papers presented in all sessions were interesting and topical and they offered firm solutions and possible directions for further research in all fields of acoustics.
